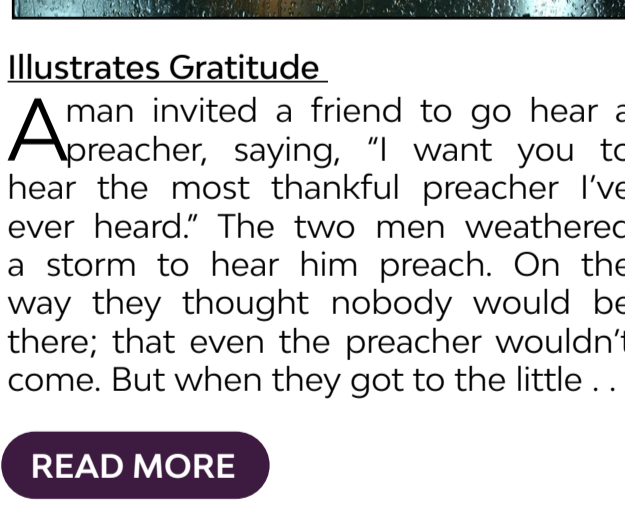
GROWING GRATITUDE

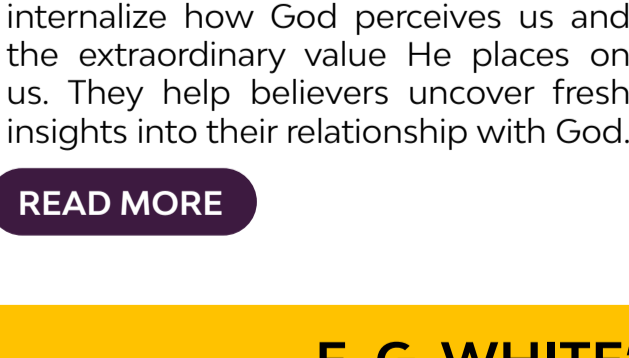

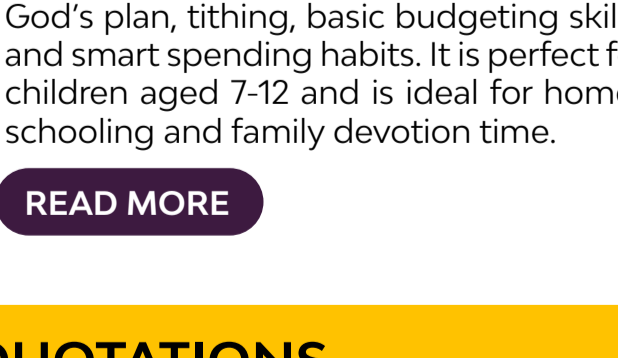

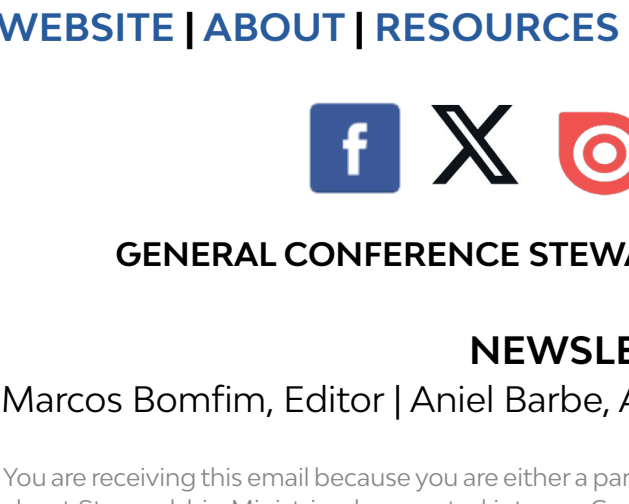
